FIRST AID

EYE CONTACT - IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do then continue rinsing. Have the product container with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

SKIN CONTACT - IF ON SKIN OR CLOTHING: Take off contaminated clothing and wash it before reuse. Wash with plenty of soap and water for several minutes. Call a poison center, doctor, chemical manufacturer, importer, or distributor to specify the appropriate source of emergency medical advice.

INGESTION - IF SWALLOWED: Immediately call a POISON CENTER or doctor/physician. Rinse mouth. Unless advised otherwise by a poison control center or doctor, have person rinse mouth with water, if able. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

INHALATION - IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, and then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth to mouth if possible.

GENERAL INFORMATION

HY-END INDUSTRIAL ADJUVANT is intended to be used with herbicides as an adjuvant that assists in holding the active ingredient/formulation on the intended target. **HY-END INDUSTRIAL ADJUVANT** increases the persistence of pesticide on the leaf or plant surface for increased effectiveness. Degradation of actives due to exposure to UV light is decreased when **HY-END INDUSTRIAL ADJUVANT** is included in the tank mix. **HY-END INDUSTRIAL ADJUVANT** also decreases the likelihood of burning the plant tissues prematurely, by decreasing the speed of translocation, but increasing the time for translocation of pesticide into the tissues. **HY-END INDUSTRIAL ADJUVANT** may be applied by ground or air.

MIXING DIRECTIONS

Follow all directions for actives being sprayed. To insure thorough mixing, maintain agitation when adding **HY-END INDUSTRIAL ADJUVANT** to the tank. Solid tank addi-

tives should be thoroughly mixed with no lumps or clumps left before adding **HY-END INDUSTRIAL ADJUVANT**. Use good agronomic practices. Use proper equipment and calibrate the equipment before use. As with any product, do not apply during extremely hot weather or when experience has shown that this and other products will cause undesired results.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool well-ventilated place. Keep in original container tightly closed. Do not reuse empty container. Do not store with food, feed, or other material to be used or consumed by humans or animals. Do not contaminate water supplies. For optimal storage, store between 40° and 90° F.

DISPOSAL: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Dispose of contents in container to an approved waste disposal facility in accordance with all local /regional/national/international regulations. Triple rinse (or equivalent) adding rinse water to application tank. Offer container for recycling or dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other procedures approved by local regulations.
